MICROLOG NOW QUOTED ON PINK SHEETS

Microlog became a public company in December 1989 and was listed on The Nasdaq Stock Market as MLOG, and in August 2001, Microlog moved to OTCBB. On March 8, 2004, Microlog filed a Form 15 to voluntarily terminate the registration of its common stock under the Securities Exchange Act in order to reduce the financial burden placed on the company by complying with the Securities and Exchange Commission rules. As a result of the filing of Form 15, the company is no longer filing current or periodic reports and financial statements with the SEC and is not subject to other requirements, including many of the provisions of the Sarbanes Oxley Act, that apply only to companies that have registered securities. Because the company is no longer required to file reports with the SEC, the common stock does not meet the eligibility requirements for quotation on the OTCBB. This led the company to move to Pink Sheets.

"Pink Sheets" is an electronic quotation system that displays quotes for many over-the-counter (OTC) securities. The name "Pink Sheets" comes from the color of paper they were historically printed on. They are published today by Pink Sheets LLC, a privately owned company. Investors are able to trade Microlog stock through broker dealers using Pink Sheets.

Microlog continues to publish financial information on a quarterly basis. Although the company does not file reports with the SEC on Forms 10-QSB and 10-KSB as it had in the past, financials are posted on Pink Sheets. Financial information are also made available upon request to holders of the company's securities by the company and to persons interested trading the company's common stock by broker dealers making quotes on the company's stock through Pink Sheets.
